15. Answer each of the following questions in about 30 words:(5questions will be given from the Reader, out of which students will have to attempt 4 questions.)
2x4=8 marks
16. Answer each of the following questions in about 30 words:
(5questions will be given from the Supplementary Reader, out of which students will have to attempt 4 questions.) **2x4=8 marks**
17. Extrapolatory value-based question, with choice
(One question will be posed from the Prose Reader and the other from the Supplementary Reader. The student will have to attempt either of the two.) **4x1=4 marks**
